Policy Statement on the Safeguarding of Children, Young People and Vulnerable Adults for the Church of St Cross, Knutsford

- As members of this church, we commit ourselves to the nurturing, protection and safekeeping of all, especially children, young people and vulnerable adults.
- It is the responsibility of each one of us to prevent the physical, sexual and emotional abuse of children, young people and vulnerable adults and to report any abuse discovered or suspected
- We recognise that our involvement with children, young people and vulnerable adults is the responsibility of the whole church
- Our church is committed to supporting, resourcing and training those who are involved with children, young people and vulnerable adults and to providing appropriate supervision
- Our church is committed to following the general guidelines and procedures as published by the Diocese of Chester
- The parish will adopt good practice guidelines
- Each person dealing with children, young people and vulnerable adults must know the guidelines and undertake to follow them. Each shall be given access to a copy of the Parish's Policy Statement and Good Practice guidelines.
- As part of our commitment to children, young people and vulnerable adults the PCC has appointed Liz Foy to the role of Parish Safeguarding Officer.
- DBS checks will be requested where necessary.
 - Children, young people and vulnerable adults are an important part of our church today
 - > They have much to give as well as to receive
 - > We will listen to them
 - As we nurture them in worship, learning and in community life, we will respect the wishes and feelings of children, young people and vulnerable adults.
